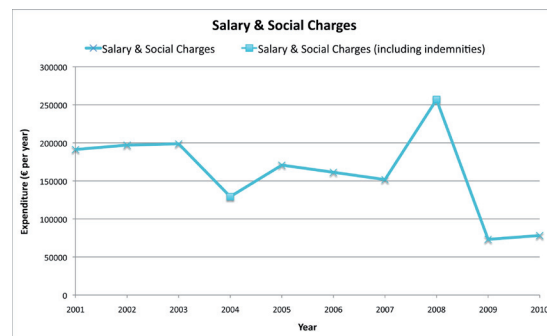
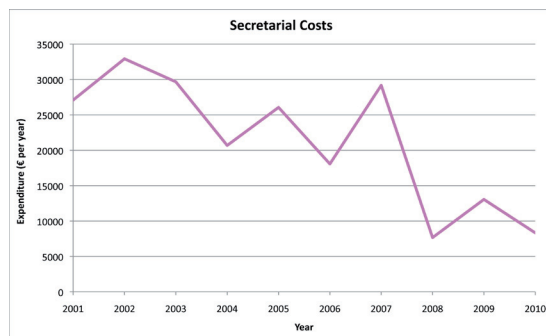
IUBS Financial Summary

Finances in 2011

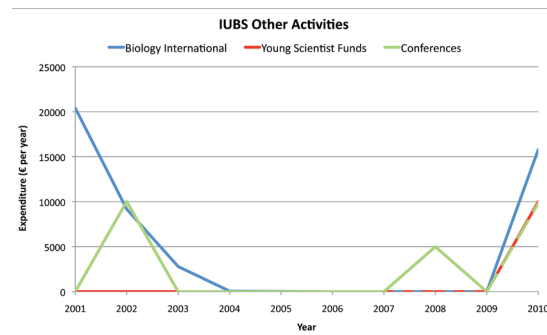
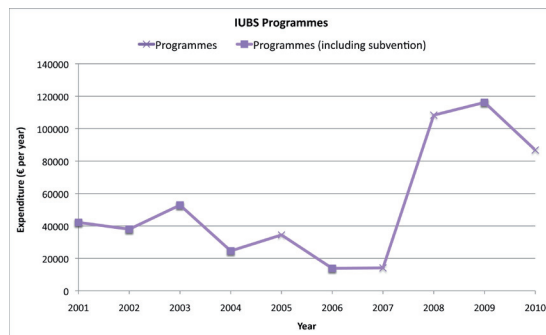
- an amount of 40 000€ has been provisionned for the organisation of the General Assembly
